



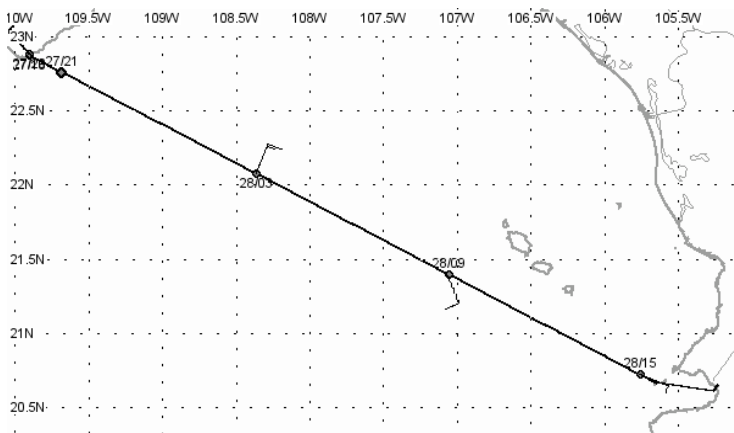

Synopsis: A trough of **LOW PRESSURE** will persist across the Sea of Cortez over the next 3 days. To its west, a ridge of **HIGH PRESSURE** covers the West Coast of the Baja Peninsula and extends w'ward for several hundred miles across adjacent E'n Pacific waters, and will move little through the 30th.

Conclusions: Tropical **LOW** #1 will remain safely south of you over the next 2-3 days as it moves w'ward south of the Sea of Cortez. Main impacts for your vessel will be SE-S swells which will abate as they propagate n'ward toward the Sea of Cortez through the 29th.



WRI HAS DETECTED A DEVELOPING **TROPICAL LOW** AT 27/15Z, **TROPICAL LOW** #1 WAS CENTERED NEAR 17.8N 105.7W (APPROXIMATELY 100NM SOUTHWEST OF MANZANILLO, MEXICO), MOVING W'WARD AT 08KTS, WITH MAXWINDS 025-035KTS. THE SYSTEM HAS POTENTIAL to be **CLASSIFIED** as a **TROPICAL DEPRESSION** or **TROPICAL STORM** within the NEXT 1-2 DAYS. WRI WILL CONTINUE TO MONITOR AND KEEP YOU UPDATED ON THE PROGRESS. Latest satellite imagery shows that the squalls have become more numerous near a disorganized **LOW** level circulation this morning. Further slow development is likely as **TROPICAL LOW** #1 moves away from land over the next 24 hours and continues a slow west to wnw'ward track the next 2-3 days.

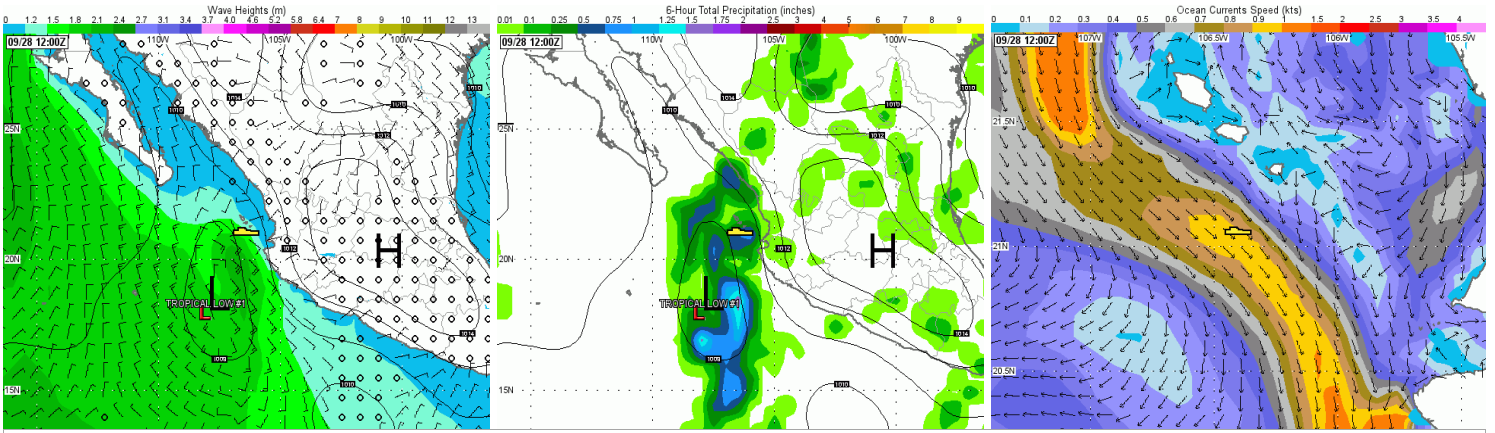


Vessel Remains at SAFE BERTH from the System.
